*** Management Practices 2/**

1/ The listed practice hold-downs are per contract, and apply to all applicants. Applicants qualifying as Historially Underserved (Beginning, Limited Resource, and Socially Disadvantaged Farmers or Ranchers) will receive an increase in payment rates; the listed hold-down per contract is not increased.

2/ Payments for a Management practice will be allowed for one to three years in the contract. Exception: Residue Management practices (329 or 345) must be scheduled for 3 consecutive years. Nutrient Mgt (590) and Pest Mgt (595) must also be scheduled in all contracts that have 329 or 345, for the same 3 years.

3/ To receive payment for practice 645 Upland Wildlife Habitat Management, there must be at least 5.0 acres of permanent cover retained from the CRP cover, and managed for wildlife benefit, or a new woody planting included in the contract.
