WA511.09 Permits

(a) Responsibility.

- (1) The district conservationist shall verify that all permits, easements and right-of-way are obtained prior to the beginning of construction.
- (2) Natural Resources Conservation Service personnel are responsible for being familiar with all permit requirements within their work area and informing owners and other responsible personnel of permit requirements in a timely manner.
- (3) The landowner shall make application for and secure all permits required for construction and operation of the proposed facility and/or structure.

(b) Coordination with landowner.

Natural Resources Conservation Service personnel shall coordinate planning and design activities with the landowner and furnish technical data required in making application.

(c) Design approval.

- (1) All construction plans and specifications submitted to federal, state, county or other local authorities to obtain permits shall be approved by the area engineer unless higher approval authority is required by WA501.04 (c) and (d).
- (2) In the event that federal, state, county or other local authorities require the design to be stamped by a licensed professional engineer NRCS registered professional engineers are encouraged to seal (stamp) designs, construction plans, reports, and other engineering documents within their job approval authority.

(d) Submission of Construction plans.

- (1) The submission of all construction plans and specifications to federal, state, county and local agencies shall be made by the land owner.

(e) Completion reports.

- (1) Natural Resources Conservation Service personnel with the appropriate construction approval authority shall insure that all construction complies with the general or special provisions of the permit as granted for the project.

- (2) Records of construction are required for all projects. If As-Built drawings, completion reports, and construction documents are required by the permitting authority, they shall be prepared by personnel responsible for construction and submitted by personnel as listed in paragraph (d).

(f) Partial list of required permits.

This partial list is provided for convenience, other permits may be required at specific locations and all personnel are responsible as stated in paragraph (a).

(1) Federal:

- PL 92-500 Section 404 Permit
- Other permits may be required for projects on federally owned or managed land

(2) State:

- Hydraulics project approval permit
- Water right
- Dam safety permit
- Storage permit
- Storm water runoff permit
- Surface mining permit
- Flood control zone permit
- Other permits may be required for projects on state owned or managed land

(3) Local and County:

- Building permits
- Shoreline management permits
- Disposal permits
- Filling and/or grading permits
- Other permits may be required for projects on locally owned or managed land
