- (4) An NRCS employee with the appropriate delegation of engineering job approval authority for “Inventory and Evaluation” will be considered as technically competent in conducting functional reviews of non-NRCS engineering work.
- (5) The functional review will determine if a technical design review according to National Engineering Manual 511.05 should be initiated. If a technical review of engineering work is deemed necessary then the NRCS employee conducting the review must possess the appropriate delegation of engineering job approval authority for “Design”. A technical review of non-NRCS engineering work shall be considered when:
 - (i) The functional review indicates that a more detailed review is needed to ensure the technical quality of the design work
 - (ii) NRCS staff has no knowledge of the experience and qualifications of the non-NRCS engineer
 - (iii) NRCS staff has direct knowledge that the engineer providing the service does not have the technical expertise
