Mr. Howard provided an overall summary of the project objectives and schedule, the areas that will be covered by the project, the deliverables for the surveys and the work completed to date.

Discussion focused on obtaining background information and identifying individuals and organizations to notify in advance of the field surveys, which are anticipated to begin the week of September 12. Ken Dixon emphasized the importance of identifying historic changes in Meadow Valley Wash through Caliente and discussion proceeded on potential sources of information.
