SCREENING CRITERIA

- A. Land not irrigated 3 out of the last 5 years is not eligible for cost-share on irrigation practices.
- B. Converting from one sprinkler-type irrigation system to another is not eligible for cost-share unless the water source is from a well..
- C. If the resource problems identified already meets the Quality Criteria for that problem they are not eligible for points or cost share under EQIP. (For example if Sheet and Rill erosion is identified as a resource problem and the RUSLE run shows the existing erosion rate with their current system is < "T" they would not be eligible to receive cost share for a given tillage system or any other applicable practices they were wanting to implement.)

ELIGIBILITY

D. A producer must implement all conservation practices necessary to meet the quality criteria in the FOTG for the identified resource concern. In other words, if a resource concern is identified and environmental points are taken, the cadre of practices or practice that enables the quality criteria to be met, must be included as a cost-shared practice(s) in the contract.
