IDAHO ONEPLAN NUTRIENT PLANNING MODEL

Idaho OnePlan Nutrient Management Planning Model Version 1.86 has been completed. The update corrects inherent errors in the Version 1.75 model based on recommendations from the Idaho Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Service, Idaho Association of Soil Conservation Districts, University of Idaho College of Agriculture, Idaho Soil Conservation Commission and Information Designs, Inc.

Version 1.86 is listed as “Nutrient Management Planner (Idaho OnePlan)” on the website at http://servicecenter.kcc.usda.gov/Sfw_a_d.htm. The download “Nutrient Management Planner (Idaho OnePlan)” is located under the Common Computing Environment/Support/Certified Software for XP Workstations, “Software From M to R.”

Once the program has been downloaded, double click on the file name, “OnePlanSetup2006Jun15.exe” and the program will self-install. Only ITS Administrators can load the program on NRCS computer systems.

The User Guide and Data Collection Worksheets, found at <http://www.id.nrcs.usda.gov/technical/>, follow the input screens for the program. If the planner completes the worksheets with the producer during the planning process (prior to data entry), plan generation will be considerably easier. Rename the worksheets each time they are used to maintain a clean copy.
