SUBJECT: ENG—MONTANA AMENDMENT TO THE NATIONAL ENGINEERING MANUAL, PART 505 – NON-NRCS ENGINEERING, SUBPART B – USE OF NON-NRCS ENGINEERING SERVICES, AND A REVISED MONTANA AMENDMENT INDEX

Purpose. To amend the National Engineering Manual, Part 505 – Use of Non-NRCS Engineering Services. Montana NRCS, requested guidance from the Montana Department of Natural Resources, and the Department of Environmental Quality on what is required when an existing ag. waste facility is located in a designated flood plain.
