Animals Enhancement Activity – ANM11-Patch-Burning to Enhance Wildlife Habitat

ATTACHMENT A – Montana Enhancement Activity Sheet Supplement

No burning will be done during the following dates:

Nesting dates: April 15 through August 1.

Fawning dates: May 1 through June 30.

The burned area does not need to be deferred from grazing after the burn. A certified burn expert does not have to supervise the burn. Burn permits shall be obtained prior to burning in counties where a permit is required.

A minimum of two burn treatments should be applied during a 5 year period.

There will be no burning of sage brush areas with a canopy cover greater than 10 percent.
