It is the responsibility of the owner to obtain all necessary permits and/or rights, and to comply with all ordinances and laws pertaining to this construction.

Construction shall be in accordance with the following special provisions:

1. Wells greater than 25 feet deep shall be decommissioned by a Licensed Water Well Contractor for the State of Montana. Wells less than 25 feet deep shall be decommissioned using Montana [Construction Specification, Well Decommissioning \(MT-351\)](#).
2. A Geology Report will be required for flowing artesian wells.
3. Upon completion of the well decommissioning, the Montana Well Abandonment Report shall be sent to the NRCS field office and the Montana Groundwater Information Center, Montana Bureau of Mines and Geology, 1300 West Park Street, Butte, MT 59701-8931. Both worksheets will be required for completion and payment of the well decommissioning.
4. The well decommissioning procedures and materials (flush water, disinfectant, grout, etc.) shall comply with State of Montana requirements.
