Expiration Date. September 30, 2013


Applications are now being accepted for the Northwest Area Representative position on the New Mexico Civil Rights Advisory Committee. The term for the above committee member position is three years with an option for a reappointment of an additional two years, by the State Conservationist, for a maximum five-year term.

The committee serves the following functions:

1. Serves as an advisory body to the State Conservationist, to promote and assist meaningful and effective affirmative action consistent with the goals and objectives set forth by management.
2. Provides feedback on the performance of Equal Opportunity and Civil Rights program, identifies areas of weakness, and makes recommendation for improvements.
3. Identifies emerging areas identified by the State Conservationist.
4. Makes recommendations to the State Conservationist regarding policies, practices, and procedures as they affect Equal Opportunity and Civil Rights in New Mexico.
5. Promotes the career employment and advancement of NRCS employees to maintain a high-quality, diverse workforce consistent with the goals of the affirmative action plan.
