# Restoring Riparian Habitat in the Southwest

USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service and producers in California, Nevada, Utah, Colorado, Arizona and New Mexico work to restore habitat for the endangered Southwestern willow flycatcher and 83 other species.



Agricultural producers work with NRCS to protect riparian habitat while improving their operations. In doing so, they receive predictability under the Endangered Species Act.
