## *Wild Pig Facts*

-  Wild pig populations are spread across the country primarily by human-aided movement and illegal releases.
-  Wild pigs in the U.S. cause more than \$1.5 billion in damages and control cost each year.
-  Wild pigs are known to carry or transmit over 30 diseases and 37 parasites.
-  APHIS provides assistance and support to landowners to remove and minimize damage caused by wild pigs.
