FOR EXAMPLE:

AREA 2: Jenkins County GARC is \$1,335 per acre. To receive 50 points on the WRP ranking worksheet, I am willing to accept 90% of the GARC. I will be offering a 10% reduction in cost per acre to NRCS. I would accept \$1,200 per acre. To receive 60 points on the ranking, I will accept 80% of the GARC or \$1,065/acre; to receive 70 points on the ranking, I will accept 70% or \$935/acre.

AREA 3: In all of Area 3 (except Bibb County), the GARC is \$1,545 per acre. To receive 50 points on the WRP ranking worksheet, I am willing to accept 90% of the GARC. I will be offering a 10% reduction in cost per acre to NRCS. I would accept \$1,390 per acre. To receive 60 points on the ranking, I will accept 80% of the GARC or \$1,235/acre; to receive 70 points on the ranking, I will accept 70% or \$1,080/acre.

AREA 4: Brantley County GARC is \$1,500 per acre. To receive 50 points on the WRP ranking worksheet, I am willing to accept 90% of the GARC. I will be offering a 10% reduction in cost per acre to NRCS. I would accept \$1,350 per acre. To receive 60 points on the ranking, I will accept 80% of the GARC or \$1,200/acre; to receive 70 points on the ranking, I will accept 70%, or \$1,050/acre.
