



Iowa Addendum: Animal Enhancement Activity – ANM09 – Grazing management to improve wildlife habitat

1. No disturbance during the nesting season from May 15 through July 15.
2. Residual plant heights shall not be less than 6 inches.
3. For establishment of herbaceous cover, use seeding mixes listed in the 327 standard.
4. Grazing management plans that impact different portions of the restored prairie at different times of the year on a rotational basis are preferred.
5. To avoid impacting the same species year after year, do not graze the same area at the same time each year.
6. Written Grazing Plan = Maintain minimum stubble heights for the primary forage functional group or species as shown in Table #1 of Iowa Agronomy Technical Bulletin #31.
