

Plant Enhancement Activity – PLT15 – Establish pollinator and/or beneficial insect habitat.

Louisiana Criteria

In addition to meeting the requirements outlined in the Enhancement Activity Sheet, species selection must emphasize as many native perennial species as practical. Annual species can be used when they add to the diversity of the planting. **Plants selected for this enhancement should come from the Louisiana Seeding Rate Tables version 1.4.**
