Louisiana Criteria

For biological treatment, plans and specifications will include a kind of grazing animal to be used and timing and duration of grazing and/or browsing.

Goats consume large amounts of browse from shrubby plants and graze a wider variety of plants than other livestock species. They would rather eat brush and weeds than grass. Browse makes up approximately 60 percent of a goat's diet.
