



Saving Data from Base Camp


Abstract

This guide outlines the steps to save data from Base Camp to a file. Base Camp cannot output to shapefiles, and instead uses GPX files. DNRGPS can read and convert GPX files to shapefiles (use this guide, then *Loading Data from File to DNRGPS*, and then *Saving Data from DNRGPS to do this conversion*).

Steps: Acquire data from GPS or file – Access a list of the data – Export the list to a GPX file


Details

1. Before you can save data from Base Camp, you need to have data from a GPS unit or another file already in Base Camp. See the guide for *Downloading Oregon GPS Data in Base Camp* for instructions on downloading your data and creating a list. If you are pulling in data from another GPX file, use **File → Import** to import an existing file with GPS data. Either process will result in a list stored under the **My Collection** folder that holds a set of GPS data.
2. From the **My Collection** folder **click** the name of the list that holds the data you want to save. When you click the list at the top of the screen, it will be highlighted and all of its data will be shown in the lower left of the screen.





- To save the data from the list, **right-click** the list and then **click *Export...***



- In the *Export* window, navigate to a folder where you will save the file.
- Change the *Save as type* to **GPS eXchange Format (*.gpx)**.
- Type a filename.
- Click Save.**
