



Loading Data from Files to DNRGPS


Abstract

This guide outlines the steps to load points stored in an existing text file, shapefile, or GPX file to DNRGPS. It is assumed an appropriate file already exists and its location on the computer is known to the user. Please refer to the appropriate GPS guide for information on loading data to DNRGPS from a GPS unit.


Steps (File): Click File → Load From → File – Navigate to file's location – select file type – select the file – click Open

Details

1. In DNR Garmin, **left-click** *File > Load From > File...*



2. In the *Load From File* window, **navigate** to the file's location on your computer.
3. To see files of a certain type listed, change the file type at the bottom of the window to be *ESRI Shapefile (*.shp)*, *GPS Exchange Format (*.gpx)*, or *Text File (comma-delimited)(*.txt)*. If you can't find your file, try a different file format.
4. **Click** the file to load.
5. **Click** the **Open** button.



6. The points from the file will load to DNRGPS and are now ready to be edited, saved as a new file, or uploaded to a GPS unit.
