



Saving Specific Records from DNRGPS

Abstract

This guide outlines steps to save only specific records from *DNRGPS*.

Steps (Selected Rows): Select the desired row or rows – Save as normal

Steps (Deletion): Delete undesired rows from the table in DNRGPS – Save data as normal

Details

Saving specific records works just like saving files normally, except the user manages the data table so that only certain records are saved to the output text file, shapefile, or GPX file.

Selected Rows

1. Load data to DNRGPS either from a file for from a GPS unit (see respective guides).
2. Select the desired row of data and save as normal. Only the selected record will save.
3. You can save multiple rows of data by using **shift-click** or **ctrl-click** to select more than one record.

Deletion Method

Use this method if you want to save most of your points, but have a few extra points that you don't need.

1. Load data to DNRGPS either from a file for from a GPS unit (see respective guides).
2. **Delete** undesired rows from the table in *DNRGPS* by **selecting** and **clicking DNRGPS's Delete** button for each undesired row. You can use **ctrl-click** to select multiple rows and then delete them.




Illustration 1: In this example, point 6 was deleted as an extran point outside of the desired group of points.

3. Save your data as normal (see the *Saving Data from DNRGPS* guide). You do not have to select rows to be saved because you deleted any undesired or extra rows of data.
