**SUBJECT: LTP—Fiscal Year 2013 Conservation Stewardship Program—Ranking Pool Acreage Allocation**

**Purpose.** Provide notification of the fiscal year (FY) 2013 acreage allocation for the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP)

**Expiration Date.** September 30, 2014

The Kansas portion of the national acres (10,605,300) for FY2013 signup is: 392,400 acres for agricultural land and 3,800 acres for nonindustrial private forest land (NIPF).

Each state is mandated to set aside five percent of its allocation for socially disadvantaged (SD) farmers or ranchers and five percent for beginning farmers/ranchers (BF/R). These totals set aside are: 39,240 acres for agricultural land.

There will be 10,000 acres kept in the state office reserve.

The available agricultural land acres were distributed to match the percent agricultural land in each area. This data was gathered from the 2007 Census of Ag.
