Nevada Centennial Ranch and Farm Awards Program

The Nevada Centennial Ranch and Farm Awards Program recognizes ranches and farms that have remained in the same family for 100 or more years.

To qualify for the award, your ranch or farm must meet the following criteria:

- a. Must have belonged to your family for at least 100 years, and
- b. Must currently be a working ranch or farm with a minimum of 160 acres, OR if less than 160 acres, must have gross yearly sales of at least \$1,000.

Recipients of Centennial Ranch and Farm Awards will be honored in a special ceremony, and will receive a sign designating their property as a Nevada Centennial Award recipient.

Applications must be received by June 1, 2013.
