

SUPPLEMENTAL WATERSHED AGREEMENT NO. 5  
FOR CHOCTAW CREEK WATERSHED, TEXAS  
BY EXCHANGE OF CORRESPONDENCE

The City of Sherman will join Grayson County Commissioners Court to share equally in all costs and responsibilities associated with acquiring land rights for Sites 8A and 9A, Choctaw Creek Watershed, without costs to the federal government. The Choctaw Watershed Water Improvement District will assist in the acquisition of land, easements, and rights-of-way, including utility, pipe line, road and improvement changes and administrative costs involved in Sites 8A and 9A.

The City of Sherman and th Grayson County Commissioners Court will share equally in the financial responsibilities for carrying out the Operations and Maintenance of Sites 8A and 9A, Choctaw Creek Watershed.

The Upper Elm-Red Soil and Water Conservation District will assist the City of Sherman and the Grayson County Commissioners Court with carrying out the Operation and Maintenance on these structures as set forth in the Operation and Maintenance Agreement for the Watershed.

All other terms, conditions and stipulations of the Watershed Plan and Agreements not modified here will remain the same and are agreed to:
