Whereas, the Watershed Work Plan Agreement for the Running Water Draw Watershed, States of Texas and New Mexico, executed by the Sponsoring Local Organizations named therein and the Service, became effective on the 28th day of May 1970; and

Whereas, in order to carry out the Watershed Work Plan for said watershed, it has become necessary to modify said Watershed Work Plan Agreement; and

Whereas, it has been found necessary to modify the Watershed Work Plan Agreement to comply with provisions of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-646, 84th Stat. 1894);

Now, therefore, the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service hereby agree on the following modifications of the terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement:

1. A paragraph numbered 15 is added to read as follows:

The Sponsoring Local Organization will provide relocation advisory assistance services and make the relocation payments to displaced persons

as required by the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-646, 84th Stat. 1894) effective as of January 2, 1971, and the Regulations issued by the Secretary of Agriculture pursuant thereto. Prior to July 1, 1972, the Sponsoring Local Organization will comply with the real property acquisition policies contained in said Act and Regulations to the extent that they are legally able to do so in accordance with their State law. After July 1, 1972, the real property acquisition policies contained in said Act shall be followed in all cases.

The Service will bear 100 percent of the first \$25,000 of relocation payment costs for any person, business, or farm operation displaced prior to July 1, 1972. Any such costs for a single dislocation in excess of \$25,000 and all costs for relocation payments for persons displaced after July 1, 1972, will be shared by the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service as follows:

<sup>1/</sup> Investigations have disclosed that under current conditions the project measures will not result in the displacement of any person, business, or farm operation. However, if relocations become necessary, relocation payments will be cost-shared in accordance with the percentages shown above.

2. The Sponsoring Local Organization and Service further agree to all other terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement not modified herein.

Whereas, the Supplemental Watershed Work Plan Agreement for the Running Water Draw Watershed, States of Texas and New Mexico, executed by the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service, became effective on the 13th day of September, 1971; and

Whereas, in order to carry out the Watershed Work Plan for said watershed, it has become necessary to modify said Watershed Work Plan Agreement; and

Whereas, since the execution of the Watershed Work Plan Agreement, as supplemented, Service policy relating to elevation at which the principal spillway inlet of floodwater retarding structures will be constructed has changed, and

Whereas, the requirement for cost sharing of construction and installation services costs of Floodwater Retarding Structure No. 1, by the Sponsoring Local Organizations, is no longer applicable.

Now, therefore, the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service hereby agree on the following modifications of the terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement, as supplemented:

1. Paragraph numbered 3 is modified with respect to Floodwater Retarding Structure No. 1 to read as follows:
