Whereas, the Watershed Plan Agreement for the Rush Creek watershed, State of Texas, executed by the Sponsoring Local Organization named therein and the Service, became effective on the 20th day of October 1966; and

Whereas, the Supplemental Watershed Plan Agreement No. I executed by the Sponsoring Local Organization named herein, and the Service became effective on the 28th day of September 1971; and

Whereas, the Supplemental Watershed Plan Agreement No. II for said watershed, executed by the Sponsoring Local Organization named therein and the Service, became effective on the 18th day of September 1974; and

Whereas, the Supplemental Watershed Plan Agreement No. III for said watershed, executed by the Sponsoring Local Organization named therein and the Service, became effective on the 27th day of April 1979; and

Whereas, in order to carry out the watershed work plan, as supplemented, for said watershed, it has become necessary to modify said Watershed Work Plan Agreement, as supplemented, and

Now, therefore, the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service hereby agree upon the following modifications of the terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement, as supplemented:

1. A paragraph numbered 8 is added to the supplemental Watershed Work Plan Agreement to read as follows:

The sponsoring local organizations do hereby agree to delete sites 3A, 6A, and 8 that are remaining to be constructed of the originally planned waterflow control structures and critical area treatment as indicated by Supplemental Watershed Work Plan Agreement dated the 27th day of April 1979. The sponsoring local organizations do also agree to forgo 20 percent of the benefits associated with deleting the remaining construction of waterflow control structures.


