Whereas, the Watershed Work Plan Agreement for the Little Elm and Laterals Watershed, State of Texas executed by the Sponsoring Local Organizations named therein and the Service, became effective on the 20th day of August 1957; and

Whereas, in order to carry out the watershed work plan for said watershed, it has become necessary to modify said Watershed Work Plan Agreement; and

Whereas, the Collin County Commissioners Court agrees to become a sponsor of the watershed work plan for said watershed for the purpose of acquiring land rights needed for the installation of remaining works of improvement to be installed in Collin County; and

Whereas, the Denton County Commissioners Court agrees to become a sponsor of the watershed work plan for said watershed for the purpose of acquiring land rights needed for the installation of remaining works of improvement to be installed in Denton County; and

Whereas, it has been found necessary to modify the Watershed Work Plan Agreement to comply with provision of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Public law 91-646, 84th Stat. 1894);

Now, therefore, the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service hereby agree on the following modifications of the terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement:

1. A paragraph is added to read as follows:

The Sponsoring Local Organization will provide relocation advisory assistance services and make the relocation payments to displaced persons as required by the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-646, 84th Stat. 1894) effective as of January 2, 1971, and the Regulations issued by the Secretary of Agriculture pursuant thereto. Prior to July 1, 1972, the Sponsoring Local Organization will comply with the real property acquisition policies contained in said Act and Regulations to the extent that they are legally able to do so in accordance with their State law. After July 1, 1972, the real property acquisition policies contained in said Act shall be followed in all cases.

The Service will bear 100 percent of the first \$25,000 of relocation payment costs for any person, business, or farm operation displaced prior to July 1, 1972. Any such costs for a single dislocation in excess of \$25,000 and all costs for relocation payments for persons displaced after July 1, 1972, will be shared by the Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service as follows:

1/ Investigations have disclosed that under current conditions the project measures will not result in the displacement of any person, business, or farm operation. However, if relocations become necessary, relocation payments will be cost-shared in accordance with the percentages shown above.

2. An additional paragraph is added to read as follows:

The program conducted will be in compliance with all requirements respecting nondiscrimination as contained in the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture (7 C.F.R. 15.1-15.12), which provide that no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

3. The Sponsoring Local Organization and the Service further agree to all other terms, conditions, and stipulations of said Watershed Work Plan Agreement not modified herein.
