


Directions for Viewing and Printing in PDF*

- Increasing magnification (Zooming in)
- Printing part of a map
- Viewing text and maps together

*Note that the PDF reader has extensive help files.

To increase magnification, do one of the following:


- 1) Select the zoom-in tool  and click on the page.
- 2) Select the zoom-in tool , click on the page, and drag to draw a rectangle around the area to magnify.
- 3) Click the magnification button  in the status bar and choose a magnification level.

To print part of a map:


First, make sure that you have Acrobat Reader 4.0 or higher installed. If you don't, download it (free) from <http://www.adobe.com/products/acrobat/readstep.html>.

Open up the PDF file. Click on the "graphic select tool" . In version 5 of Acrobat Reader, the graphic select tool is on the tool bar. In version 4, the graphic select tool is concealed

behind the "text select tool" . Click on the text select tool button and hold it down until some other button choices

appear . Hold down the mouse button and slide over to the graphic select tool.

The cursor turns into crosshairs. Click and drag the crosshairs to select the part of the image you want to print. From the main tool bar, select File > Print. "Selected graphic" should be checked in the section "Print range." Selecting "Fit to page" causes the selected area to enlarge to the size of the page.



NOTE: FOR ADOBE ACROBAT VERSION 6.0 USE THE SNAPSHOT TOOL TO OUTLINE THE IMAGE INSTEAD OF THE SELECT TEXT TOOL. THE SNAPSHOT TOOL IS LOCATED TO THE RIGHT OF THE SELECT TEXT TOOL ON THE TOOL BAR. THEN SELECT FILE >> PRINT.

To view the text and a map together using Acrobat Reader:

From the starting page, click on "Index to Map Sheets."

From the Index to Map Sheets., click on your area of interest and zoom in as desired.

On the main menu bar, select File > Open > Filename.pdf.

On the main menu bar, select Window > Tile > Vertically.

To view the text and a map together using an Internet browser:

Open the browser twice and resize the windows so that they both fit onscreen.
