## Data Collection on Cover Crop Study Begins

Jamie L. Whitten Plant Materials Center staff recently began collecting initial data on cover crop plots in Sunflower and Tippah counties in Mississippi. Percent cover data was recorded. The goal of this study is to assess the ability of wheat, rye, daikon radish, and crimson clover to restore soil physical properties altered by land leveling.
