## **Reasonable Accommodations for Individuals with Disabilities**

---

If you have a disability, it is helpful to know that the government makes it a priority to provide reasonable accommodations to individuals with disabilities. Federal agencies provide reasonable accommodations to individuals with disabilities, as long as you meet the job qualifications.

### **Some of the accommodations provided include:**

- TTYs for use with telephones
- Hardware and software that make computers accessible if you have vision impairments or difficulty using your hands
- Sign language interpreters or readers
- Training and other written materials in alternative formats (e.g., braille, audio tape, computer disk)
- Physical changes, such as installing a ramp or modifying a workspace
