Swamp White Oak Woodland

Site Characteristics: Stands occur on silt loam soils formed over glacial till or loess. This savanna-like community is found on silt loam soils over glacial till or loess.

Vegetation Characteristics: This community has an open tree canopy dominated by Swamp White Oak with Bur Oak sparse to codominant. Post Oak, Northern Red Oak and White Oak may also be found, especially on the drier portions of this mesic to wet-mesic community.

Range:

Conservation Status: G1 - Critically Imperiled

Management Considerations: Historically, stands were more open than they are today. Fire was the natural disturbance, although decreased fire frequency has likely led to more dense canopies in current examples. Fires were part of the historic natural disturbance regime that kept these stands open
