


NRCS facilitates a coordinated resource management planning process that is designed to streamline and reduce duplication for producers when working with multiple agencies.

NRCS Resource Concerns and Practices


- The AZ State Technical Committee has identified 8 natural resource concerns related to air quality.
- 43 NRCS conservation practices address air quality, including conservation activity plans for air quality management and energy management.





EQIP Air Quality Initiative

- ▶ For FY-2012, close to \$2 million has been allocated for the EQIP Air Quality Initiative.
- To date, NRCS has obligated \$8.8 million in financial assistance on 97,082 acres to address:
 - Particulate matter
 - Reduced visibility
 - Excess ozone
 - Objectionable Odors
