**Establish monarch butterfly habitat**

**Additional Criteria for Kansas**

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E327B, the following apply in Kansas:

- Where milkweed seed is not available, use seed mixtures where 80% of forbs are identified as key plant species for monarchs.

**Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas**

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E327B, the following applies in Kansas:

- For monarchs, use the Wildlife Habitat Evaluation Guide (WHEG) to identify benchmark resource and planned conditions.
