Additional Criteria for Kansas

Acceptable resource conserving crops:

Perennial Grasses	Legumes*	Cover/Green Manure Crop**
Refer to Kansas NRCS Pasture and Hay Planting (512) standard	Alfalfa	Annual/Biennial Legumes (clovers, vetch, etc.) – refer to 512 standard
	Birdsfoot Trefoil	Corn
	White Clover (Dutch, Ladino)	Sorghum, Forage sorghum, Sudangrass
	Red Clover	Legume Crops (Soybeans, Mungbeans, Winter Peas, Cowpeas, etc.)
		Small Grains – (includes wheat, rye, oats, barley, triticale)
		Cover Crop Mix - includes a minimum of one legume and one grass species – refer to 340 standard

*Select perennial or biennial legumes to ensure growth beyond the first year of seeding. Refer to CPS 512, Conservation Practice Standard, for seeding rates, dates, and zones.

** For single species stands, refer to 512 Pasture and Hay Planting seeding rates, dates, and zones. For multi-species cover crop stands, refer to CPS 340, Conservation Practice Standard for seeding rates, dates, and zones. Complete Implementation Requirement Forms KS-ECS-4 or KS-ECS-6, as applicable.
