### E340B

## Intensive cover cropping to increase soil health and soil organic matter content

### Additional Criteria for Kansas

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E340B, the following apply in Kansas:

- This enhancement is intended to enhance a crop rotation and provide soil coverage during ALL non-crop production periods. The non-crop production period is any time between harvest of one crop and planting of the next crop. Plant a cover crop during any non-crop production period 30 days or longer. With double crops (harvested in late October and November) consider overseeding/interseeding a cover crop prior to harvest.
- Utilize plant species, seedbed preparation, seeding rates, seeding dates, seeding depths, fertility requirements, and planting methods consistent with applicable local criteria and soil/site condition requirements from Table 1 of Form KS-ECS-6, Cover Crop Design.
- Observe all criteria found in Kansas Agronomy Technical Note KS-43, Organic Matter Matrix.

### Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E340B, the following applies in Kansas:

- Use Form KS-ECS-6, Cover Crop Design.
