Intensive orchard/vineyard floor cover cropping to increase soil health

Additional Criteria for Kansas

- Utilize plant species, seedbed preparation, seeding rates, seeding dates, seeding depths, fertility requirements, and planting methods consistent with applicable local criteria and soil/site conditions. For this information, refer to the Planting section of the performance table in the Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 340, Cover Crop, Construction Specifications.
- If soil is lacking the specific rhizobium bacteria for the selected legume, treat the seed with the appropriate inoculum at the time of planting. If not planted in the last five years, inoculate legume seeds.
- Select a minimum of three species cover crop mix on the basis of producing higher volumes of organic material and root mass to maintain or increase soil organic matter. Use species with an excellent or very good rating in Table 1 of Form [KS-ECS-6](#), Cover Crop Design.
