**Enhanced field borders to increase food for pollinators
along the edge(s) of a field**

Additional Criteria for Kansas

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E386D, the following apply in Kansas:

- Use Kansas Biology Technical Note No. 37, Pollinator Biology and Habitat Technology, for seed mix development and habitat management guidance for pollinators.
- For cover establishment of field borders, refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, Wildlife Habitat f. Mixes, for details.
- Avoidance dates for vegetation management after establishment are:
 - Upland bird nesting dates are April 15 to July 15.
 - Migratory bird nesting dates are April 1 to July 15.
 - Fawning dates are May 20 to June 10.

Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E386D, the following applies in Kansas:

- Use Form KS-ECS-4, Grass Seeding, for documentation of seeding design/certification.
