**Increase riparian herbaceous cover width to enhance
wildlife habitat**

Additional Criteria for Kansas

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E390B, the following apply in Kansas:

- For cover establishment of herbaceous riparian vegetation, refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, Mixes, for details.
- For forbs and legumes that provide pollen and nectar for native pollinators, refer to Kansas Biology Technical Note 37, Pollinator Biology and Habitat Technology.
- Avoidance dates for vegetation management after establishment are:
 - Upland bird nesting dates are April 15 to July 15.
 - Migratory bird nesting dates are April 1 to July 15.
 - Fawning dates are May 20 to June 10.
- Refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 382, Fence, for design. Additional information for constructing wildlife friendly fences can be found in the Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks publication "A Landowner's Guide to Wildlife Friendly Fences: How to Build Fence with Wildlife in Mind."

Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E390B, the following applies in Kansas:

- Use Form KS-ECS-4, Grass Seeding, for documentation of seeding design/certification.
