Conservation Practice 511: Forage Harvest Management

Additional Criteria for Kansas

- In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E511D, the following apply in Kansas:
 - Hay cutting in Kansas will occur no later than **September 1** of the given year to allow adequate regrowth before winter dormancy.
 - Utilize the CART national wildlife questions for the appropriate land use. In order to convert to a WHEG score, take the CART score and divide by 100. For example: CART score = 50, WHEG score would be calculated $(50/100) = 0.50$.

Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

- In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E511D, the following apply in Kansas:
 - Include a measurement reference (yard stick or grazing stick held vertically) in the photo documentation to clearly show forage height.
