Additional Criteria for Kansas

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E550A, the following apply in Kansas:

- Use Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, for detailed guidance on meeting criteria.
 - Refer to appropriate Ecological Site Description (ESD) functional/structural (F/S) groups and plant species information in the reference community for guidance in species to include in the mixture.
- Refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, Section 10, for management practices during establishment.
- Refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, Section 11, for determining stand establishment.
 - Procedures for determining stand adequacy are outlined in Kansas Agronomy Technical Note KS-27, Establishment guide for both herbaceous and woody plantings used on conservation programs.

Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E550A, the following applies in Kansas:

- Use Form KS-ECS-4, Grass Seeding, for seeding design and certification.
