**Range planting for improving forage, browse, or cover for wildlife**

**Additional Criteria for Kansas**

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E550B, the following apply in Kansas:

- Use Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, for detailed guidance on meeting criteria.
  - Use requirements found in Section 7c.–Wildlife Habitat Mixes to develop the seeding mix.
  - Refer to appropriate Ecological Site Description (ESD) functional/structural (F/S) groups and plant species information in the reference community for guidance in species to include in the mixture.
- Refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, Section 10, for management practices during establishment.
- Refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 550, Range Planting, Construction Specifications, Section 11, for determining stand establishment.
  - Procedures for determining stand adequacy are outlined in Kansas Agronomy Technical Note KS-27, Establishment guide for both herbaceous and woody plantings used in conservation programs.

**Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas**

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E550B, the following apply in Kansas:

- Use Form KS-ECS-4, Grass Seeding, for seeding design and certification.
