Additional Criteria for Kansas

- Current soil tests, no older than two years, for phosphorus (P), potassium (K), and potential of hydrogen (pH), and annually for nitrogen (N) and chlorine (Cl).
- Follow Kansas State University soil fertility recommendations for nutrients and soil amendments.
