Additional Criteria for Kansas

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E612E, the following apply in Kansas:

- Through NRCS, a Kansas Forest Service (KFS) district forester may be requested to assist the producer with practice planning.
- Refer to Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 612, Tree/Shrub Establishment, Construction Specifications, and Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 380, Windbreak/Shelterbelt Establishment, Construction Specifications, for tree planting information.

Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E612E, the following apply in Kansas:

- Use Form KS-ECS-4, Grass Seeding, and/or Form KS-ECS-5, Tree/Shrub Planting, for certification that the application meets design requirements.
- A detailed map identifying locations of forest stand improvement activities (using a Global Positioning System [GPS] unit) meeting NRCS specifications will be included with planning documentation.
