Tree/shrub planting for wildlife food

Additional Criteria for Kansas

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E612G, the following apply in Kansas:

- Through NRCS, a Kansas Forest Service (KFS) district forester and/or a wildlife biologist may be requested to work with the producer to complete a tree/shrub planting plan.
- Refer to Kansas Forestry Technical Note No. KS-10, Conservation Tree/Shrub Plantings Suitability Groups, Windbreak Suitability Groups, and Plantings for Kansas, for tree/shrub adaptability.

Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E612G, the following apply in Kansas:

- A map identifying the location of cropland conversion to trees and shrubs will be included with planning documents.
- Complete Form KS-ECS-5, Tree/Shrub Planting, to document tree plan.
