**Crop tree management for mast production**

**Additional Criteria for Kansas**

In addition to the criteria specified in National Enhancement E666132Z1, the following apply in Kansas:

- Develop a Forest Stewardship Plan (FSP) to inventory existing vegetation to determine management of the resource. Through NRCS, a Kansas Forest Service (KFS) district forester may be requested to complete a FSP and to assist the producer with practice planning.
- A degraded plant condition as the result of diseases or improper management will be identified in the FSP.
- Refer to [Kansas Conservation Practice Standard 666](#), Forest Stand Improvement, Construction Specifications, for practice assistance.

**Additional Documentation Requirements for Kansas**

In addition to the documentation requirements specified in National Enhancement E666I, the following apply in Kansas:

- A detailed map identifying locations of forest stand improvement activities using a Global Positioning System (GPS) unit meeting NRCS specifications will be included with planning documentation.
