

## NRCS CSP Food Producing Plant List

- black walnut *Juglans nigra*
- butternut walnut *Juglans cinerea* (range is generally limited to north Alabama)
- pecan *Carya illinoensis*
- pawpaw *Asimina triloba*
- native persimmon *Diospyros spp*
- non-native persimmon *Diospyros spp* adapted to Alabama
- crabapple varieties adapted to Alabama
- wild plums native to Alabama
- non-native plums adapted to Alabama
- citrus varieties adapted to the climate in south Alabama (only allowed in those counties)
- chestnut varieties adapted to Alabama
- apple varieties adapted to Alabama
- old southern pear varieties *Pyrus spp* (caution: rootstock can be invasive if allowed to resprout after parent plant dies) Restricted to old southern varieties that produce edible fruit. Bradford and other ornamental pears are NOT allowed.
- muscadine/scuppernong varieties adapted to Alabama
- grape varieties adapted to Alabama
- elderberry
- blueberry varieties adapted to Alabama
- raspberry varieties adapted to Alabama
- blackberry varieties adapted to Alabama
- dewberry varieties adapted to Alabama
- mulberry varieties adapted to Alabama
