<u>Overview:</u> The Trimble T10 tablet has multiple settings for the responsiveness of the touchscreen.

- Finger Mode is the default setting
- *Glove Mode* is intended to work with touchscreen (capacitive) friendly gloves and rubber tipped styluses.
- *Water Mode* is intended to enhance responsiveness when the screen gets wet.

Setting the Touch Mode

- 1. Turn on the T10 tablet and launch *Control Center*. You can search for it in the Windows Start Menu by typing in "Control Center"
- 2. <u>Tap</u> Open to launch it.



3. If a User Account Control window pops up, select Yes.



4. Within Control Center, *Touch Mode* is one of the settings.
