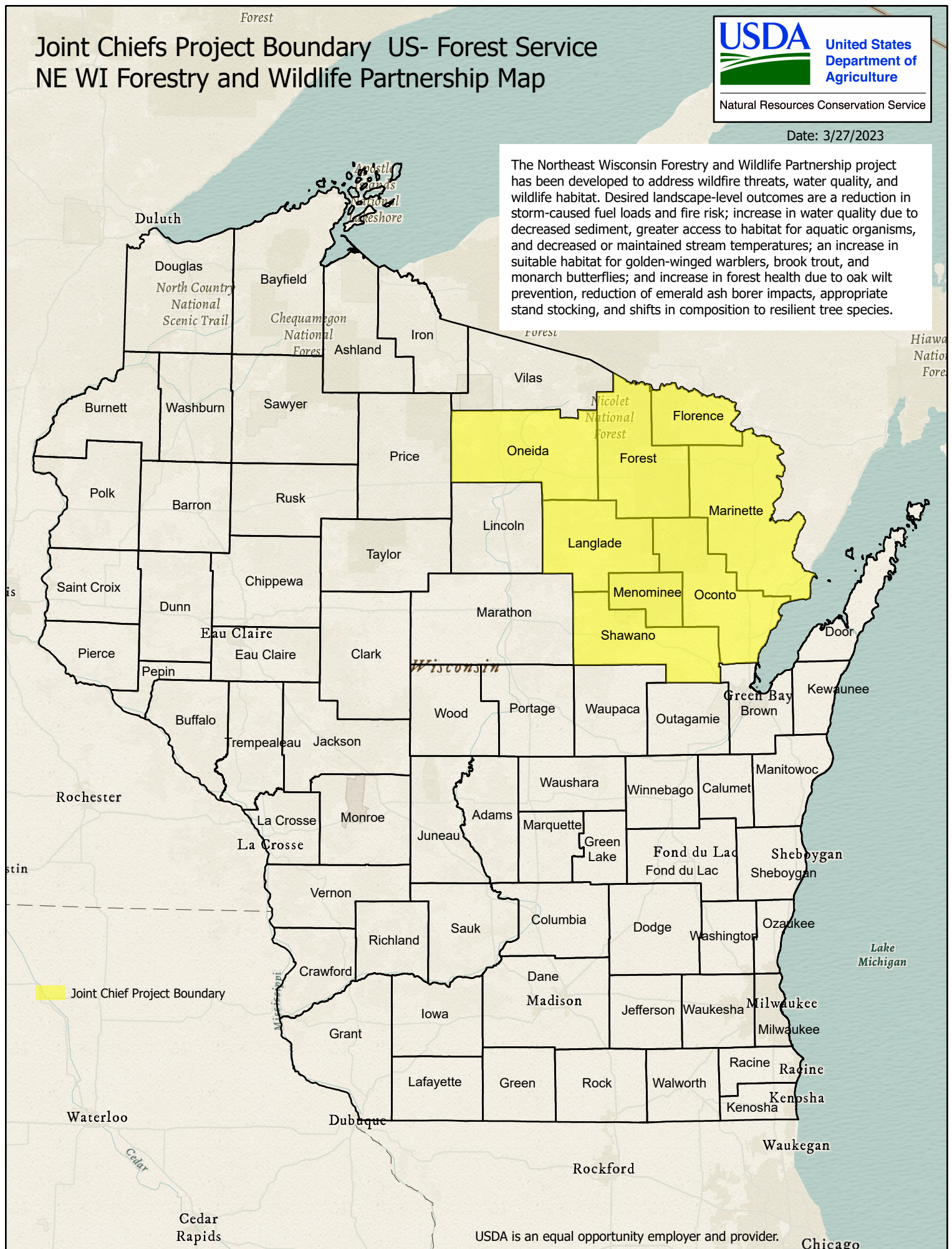


Joint Chiefs Project Boundary US- Forest Service NE WI Forestry and Wildlife Partnership Map

The Northeast Wisconsin Forestry and Wildlife Partnership project has been developed to address wildfire threats, water quality, and wildlife habitat. Desired landscape-level outcomes are a reduction in storm-caused fuel loads and fire risk; increase in water quality due to decreased sediment, greater access to habitat for aquatic organisms, and decreased or maintained stream temperatures; an increase in suitable habitat for golden-winged warblers, brook trout, and monarch butterflies; and increase in forest health due to oak wilt prevention, reduction of emerald ash borer impacts, appropriate stand stocking, and shifts in composition to resilient tree species.
