
Nevada 2023 GARC



Nevada – FY 2023 Geographic Area Rate Caps Wetland Reserve Easements

- GARC Rate = 85% Fair Market Value (FMV) based on Individual USPAP Appraisal
- 30 year easements and Tribal LUC Rate = 75% of GARC Rate = 63.75% net FMV
- Perpetual easement Reserve Grazing Rights Option = 75% of GARC Rate = 63.75% net FMV
- 30 year easements and Tribal LUC Rate Reserve Grazing Rights Option = 75% of GARC Rate X .75 = 47.81% net FMV
