What is Farmers.gov?

Farmers.gov is an online portal that has various functions and allows different tools and information to be available to producers. These features include:

- View, upload, download, and e-sign documents
- Request conservation assistance
- Request financial assistance, including submitting a program application
- View and request application details
- Reference technical terms and submit questions
- Access information on current and past conservation practices
- View, print, and export detailed farm records and farm/tract maps
- View detailed information on all previous and ongoing contracts, including some costshare assistance received and anticipated

Who can make an account?

- Customers who need access to entity data (such as LLC or Trust) or to act on behalf of another customer
 - Must first login as themselves with their own eAuthentication account
- Individuals with both an eAuthentication account and representative authority to act on behalf of another customer (entity or individual)
 - Will have the ability to 'Switch Profiles' after login
 - 'Switch Profile' is available for active representative authority relationship

Creating a Farmers.gov Account

To create a Farmers.gov account, you will need an individual customer USDA eAuthentication (eAuth) account linked to your USDA Business Partner (BP) customer record. To ensure you have a USDA Business Partner customer record, please contact your local USDA Service Center.



Once you have confirmed you have a current USDA Business Partner customer record you can follow the steps below in creating your account.

- Visit the Farmers.gov login page and select "Create Account"
- 2. Follow the steps and verify your identity
 - Select Create Account as a
 "Customer" on the eAuth account registration page and follow the directions on the site
- 3. To keep personal information protected and secure, there are 2 options to verify your identity:
 - a. Verify your identity online during the registration process using the USDA self-service Online Identity Verification Application (recommended)
 - b. Schedule a visit to your USDA Service Center for in-person identity verification with a Local Registration Authority (LRA) employee.
- 4. Log in to Farmers.gov
