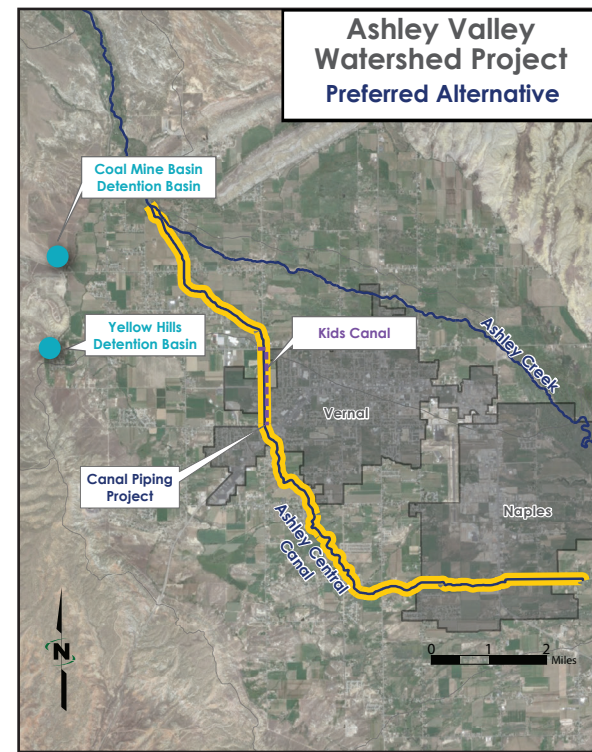


Ashley Valley Watershed Flood & Irrigation Project - Uintah County, Utah

Final Plan-EA & FONSI Notice of Availability

The United States Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) and Uintah County **announce the availability of the Final Watershed Plan and Environmental Assessment (Plan-EA) and the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the Ashley Valley Watershed Flood & Irrigation Project (Project)**. The Project proposes the following improvements within the Ashley Valley Watershed in Uintah County, Utah:

- **Piping and Pressurization** – Improve agricultural water management to reduce water lost to seepage and evaporation, improve efficiency of irrigation delivery, improve downstream water quality, and provide an opportunity for future on-farm improvements.
- **Kids Canal** – Improve existing Kids Canal Parkway path with an asphalt surface, two pedestrian bridges, benches, garbage cans, ADA ramps, shade structures and picnic tables. As part of the cultural mitigation, an informational kiosk on the Kids Canal history will be constructed along the path, supplemental water shares will be purchased and diverted into Kids Canal to sustain the trees that remain along the canal after construction and to provide open water for aesthetic and passive recreation purposes, and public outreach materials with the Kids Canal history will be produced.
- **Detention Basins** – Detain peak runoff in the project area to protect land and community infrastructure from flood related damages.
