Purpose

From August 25 through September 4, 2023, Earth Team volunteers, Fort Morgan, Colorado, Major Land Resource Area (MLRA) Soil Survey Office (SSO) staff, NRCS field and area office staff, and Pueblo, Colorado, MLRA SSO staff participated in the 2023 Colorado State Fair.

Key Outcomes

The Team set up the Soil Exhibit in the Ag Pavilion to share soil heath information with fair visitors. The soil exhibit at the 2023 Colorado State Fair included the soil health tunnel and Mighty Mini Microbe.

The Team used scavenger hunts to encourage fair visitors to learn more about soils. These were a hit with all, especially the younger crowd who enjoyed searching for answers inside and outside of the tunnel. Soil profile cards and bean seed necklaces were also used to spread soil health information, and by the end of the week, fair visitors had made eight-hundred soil profile cards and seed necklaces.
